Since 1992, VDQS decrees during each conference a price, to honor the best contribution to alcoholometry. Other rewards, of local initiative, are decreed each year to lecturers distinguished by a jury.

The association wishes to gather all the European specialists, and the better world specialists about wine.

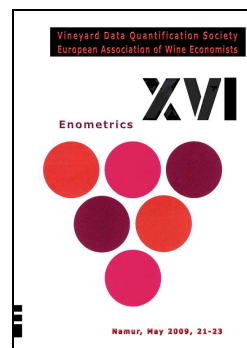

Enometrics is defined as a number of:

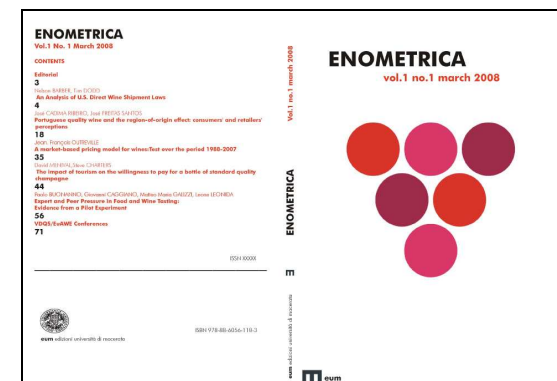
Originally (1838), measurement of the alcohol content of wine; now Discipline devoted to measurement of activities and products linked to wines and alcoholic beverages.
