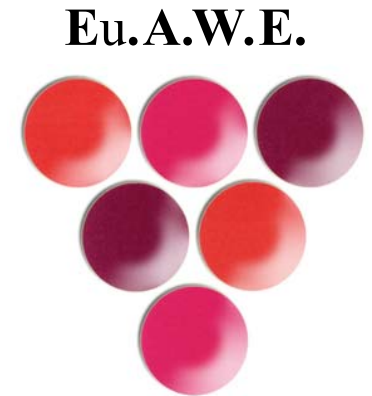

Founded in 1991, VDQS, Association Loi 1901 aims to : Promote the exchanges of research in theoretical and applied oenometric

The interest of the scientific community to the problems involved in the wines markets and their environment make VDQS organize each year a conferences on these topics.

Promote relationships between its members

Encourage teaching and research

Since 1992, VDQS decrees during each conference a price, to honour the best contribution to alcoholometry. Other rewards, of local initiative, are decreed each year to lecturers distinguished by a jury.

VDQS represents Economists and Econometricians or professionals, at the regional, national or international levels.

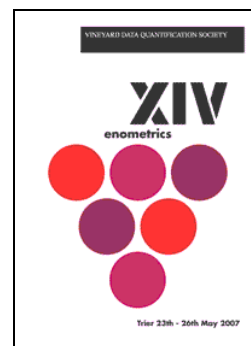
